# Important Public Notice

The election voting precincts listed on the reverse side of this page have been **consolidated** in order to comply with the Federal/State mandate that each polling location have a HAVA-compliant (**Help America Vote Act of 2002) Direct Recording Electronic (DRE)** voting unit. In order to meet federal requirements, at least one accessible direct recording voting system (DRE) must be placed at each polling site for individuals with disabilities. All voters are to be redirected to the new locations listed.

Caldwell County has a total of thirty (30) HAVA Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) voting units available. A total of 52 (HAVA-DRE's) voting units are actually needed to provide both parties with an allocation of 26 each (one for each polling location). The County has asked both parties to share the existing (30) HAVA -DRE voting units for the Primary Election (four units are reserved for County use during Early Voting). This means that a total of only 26 HAVA -DRE's are available for use during the Primary Election: thirteen (13) DRE voting units for the Democrats and thirteen (13) DRE voting units for the Republicans.

The Democratic Party, with only thirteen (13) DRE's, **MUST consolidate twenty-six (26) voting boxes to thirteen (13) voting boxes,**

The Democratic Party will be using the following voting systems:

1. Standard Optical Scan Voting System "Paper Ballots" and
2. HAVA Compliant Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) voting units. (Required by Federal/State mandate)
